PASSAIC COUNTY WOMEN'S CENTER

Passaic County Women's Center (PCWC) is a private, non-profit organization serving survivors of domestic violence and sexual violence in all forms. PCWC is a division of the New Jersey Association on Correction. Since the center's inception, the services have expanded to include a variety of programs addressing the complex issues of domestic violence and sexual assault. Services are provided to any individual who is a survivor of domestic violence and/or sexual assault, or who is a person of support to a survivor of domestic violence and/or sexual assault regardless of sex, gender, gender identity, race, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, economic status, or immigration status.

PCWC is open and operational 24 hours per day, 365 days per year. Services may be accessed through a 24-hour hotline, either directly by clients or though referral services. A drop-in outreach center is available to the general public during business hours. PCWC provides emergency shelter for women and their children, as well as a full spectrum of ancillary support services. Extensive services are available to anyone concerned with the issues of domestic violence and sexual assault in Passaic County, whether they are in need of shelter or not. These services include but are not limited to:

- -Legal advocacy
- -Children's programs
- -Community education and prevention
- -Emergency shelter
- -Crisis intervention and counseling

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

- Live or work within one hour of the three Passaic County hospitals that provide SART services: St. Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson, St. Mary's Hospital in Passaic, and Chilton Memorial Hospital in Pequannock Township
- · At least 18 years old
- · Completion of PCWC's 40 hour training program
- · Access to a reliable cell phone
- · Access to a reliable vehicle
- Volunteers must demonstrate stability and success in their personal and professional life
- Be responsible, committed, compassionate and openminded
- · Able to maintain and respect confidentiality
- · Have no history of perpetration of abuse or violence
- · Must pass a criminal background check
- Must be able to attend all training sessions and mandatory monthly SART Team meetings
- We also ask that survivors of sexual assault who would like to become volunteers be at least one year past their assault and have done the healing work necessary to be in a healthy emotional state to be able to help others in crisis.




ADDITIONAL DETAILS

Commitment:

- · We ask for a minimum commitment of one year
- At minimum: Three 8-hour on-call shifts per month (24 hours total/month), for a year
- Shifts include overnights, weekends and holidays

Training:

All applicants selected as candidates for the Sexual Assault Response Team shall be required to successfully complete the SART training before being permitted to respond to any Team activations. We strive to offer 1-2 trainings per year, but circumstances do not always allow us to offer two trainings. Passaic County Women's Center provides an approximately 40-hour training program, free of charge, over twelve sessions facilitated by PCWC staff. Training provides both skill development and personal growth work through a series of lectures, readings, videos, group discussions, activities, and role play opportunities.
